The Government of Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the One WaSH National Program (CWA-II), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Drilling of Shallow wells, supply and installation of Afredeve hand pump at different Woredas of Tigray. "For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing."

2. Tigray Water and Energy Bureau now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for drilling of shallow wells, supply and installation of Afredeva hand pumps. Lot-1 # 20 (Almata and Ofla) and Lot-2 # 10 (Gulomekeda and Chila) completion period 5 days per shallow well and no margin of preference is applied.

3. Bidding will be conducted through national competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers Projects Financing, dated July 2016, revised November 2017 and August 2018, and is open to all Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.

6. Bids must be delivered to the address below Tigray Water and Energy Bureau on or before 3:00 Local Time, 20 February 2025. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below Tigray Water and Energy Bureau on 3:15 Local Time, 20 February 2025.

7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of for Lot-1 170,000 ETB (One Hundred Seventy Thousand Ethiopian Birr) and Lot-2 85,000.00 (Eighty Five Thousand Ethiopian Birr). Bid Documents will be purchased from OWNP procurement Section Room No.111 New Building. Starting from 21 January 2025.
